## Add and Subtract Decimals

To add or subtract decimals, line up the decimal points in the problems. Finding an estimate first will help you determine if your answer is reasonable.

| First estimate. | Then, subtract to find the exact answer. |
| :---: | :---: |
| $19.846{ }^{\text {® }}$ (®) 20 | 19.846 |
| - 6.684-7 | -6.684 |
| 13 | 13.162 |
| The answer should be close to 13 . | 13.162 is close to the estimate, so the answer is reasonable. |

My Real Life
Hala has 106.87 dirhams. She pays 56.75 Dirhams for a book that she bought from the bookshop. How much money does she still have?

106.87-56.75 =?
106.87

- 56.75
$50.12 \rightarrow$ Hala is left with 50.12 Dirhams.
