

**Algebra: Add 3 Numbers**

Adding three numbers involves two steps.

Step 1: Mentally add the first two numbers.

Step 2: Add the other number to this sum.

Examples:

Write the sum

1)  $3 + 2 + 7$

$$\begin{aligned} &\underbrace{3 + 2}_{3+2=5} + 7 \\ &= 5 + 7 \\ &= 12 \end{aligned}$$

2)  $1 + 1 + 6$

$$\begin{aligned} &1 + \underbrace{1 + 6}_{1+1=2} \\ &= 2 + 6 \\ &= 8 \end{aligned}$$

3)  $4 + 7 + 2$

$$\begin{aligned} &\underbrace{4 + 7}_{4+7=11} + 2 \\ &= 11 + 2 \\ &= 13 \end{aligned}$$

4)  $4 + 5 + 8$

$$\begin{aligned} &\underbrace{4 + 5}_{4+5=9} + 8 \\ &= 9 + 8 \\ &= 17 \end{aligned}$$

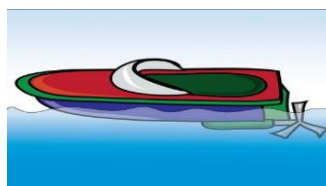
**My Real Life**

A) Lin has 3 red fish, 4 blue fish, and 5 yellow fish. How many fish does Lin have?



$$3 + 4 + 5 = \underline{12} \text{ fish}$$

B) Amir has 3 blue boats, 2 red boats, and 3 yellow boats. How many boats does he have?



$$3 + 2 + 3 = \underline{8} \text{ boats}$$
