
Circles


A circle is made of points that are the same distance from a fixed point called the center. There are different parts to a circle.

The center is the point In the middle of a circle.


A radius is a line segment that has one end point on the center and the other end point on the circle.




A diameter is a line segment that has both end points on the circle and runs through the center.




The circumference is the distance around the circle.





Name the red part in the circle below.



- \cdot The red part is a line segment with 2 end points on the circle.
- · The red part passes through the center of the circle.

So, the red part is a diameter.
