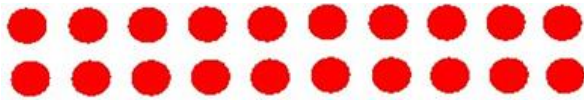


Divide by 2 and 5

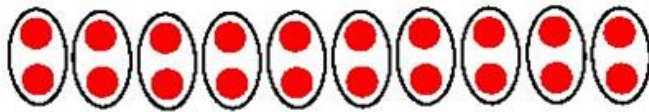
You can draw a picture to show how to divide.

Find the quotient.

$$20 \div 2$$



Draw 20 counters to show the dividend.



Circle groups of 2 to show the divisor.

There are 10 groups of 2.
The quotient is 10.

So, $20 \div 2 = 10$.

Find the quotient.

$$15 \div 5$$

You can use a related multiplication fact.

$$\text{Think : } 3 \times 5 = 15$$

So, $15 \div 5 = 3$.

Examples:

A- Find the quotient

1) $6 \div 2 = \underline{3}$

2) $\underline{7} = 35 \div 5$

3) $10 \div 5 = \underline{2}$

4) $\underline{9} = 18 \div 2$

5) $\underline{9} = 45 \div 5$

6) $\underline{5} = 10 \div 2$

My Real Life

A) Lama counts a total of 15 birds at the bird feeders in the park. She counts 5 birds at each feeder. How many bird feeders are in the park?

$$\underline{15 \div 5 = 3 \text{ bird feeders}}$$

B) Maha sees the same number of birds each hour for 2 hours. She sees 16 birds in all. How many birds does Maha see each hour?



$$\underline{16 \div 2 = 8 \text{ birds}}$$
