

## Double and Near Doubles

The addends are the same in a doubles fact.

Examples:

$1) 1 + 1 = 2$

$2) 7 + 7 = 14$

$3) 3 + 3 = 6$

$4) 2 + 2 = 4$

One of the addends is 1 more in a doubles - plus - one fact

To find the sum of  $5 + 6$

Find the double of the smaller number

Add one to the sum

$5 + 6$

5 is the smaller number

Double 5 is 10

$10 + 1 = 11$

$5 + 6 = 11$

Examples:

$5) 3 + 4 = 7$

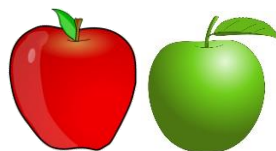
$6) 5 + 4 = 9$

$7) 7 + 6 = 13$

$8) 5 + 4 = 9$

## My Real Life

A) Sara has 6 green apples and 7 red apples. How many apples does she have?



$6 + 7 = \underline{13} \text{ apples}$

B) Jad has 3 pens. Iman has 1 more pen than Jad. How many pens do they have together?

Step 1: If Iman has 1 more pen more than Jad, then Iman has  $3 + 1 = 4$  pens.

Step 2: Add the number of pens Jad has to the number of pen Iman has.



$3 + 4 = \underline{7} \text{ pens}$
