## Multiply with 6

You can multiply by 6 using a number line.
Find the product: $\qquad$ $=6 \times 4$.

The factor 6 tells you to make 6 jumps.
The factor 4 tells you that each jump should be 4 spaces.
So, $6 \times 4$ means 6 jumps of 4 spaces each.
Start at 0.
Make 6 jumps of 4 spaces each.


Stop at 24 .
So, $24=6 \times 4$.

$6 \times 6=36$ people
