Multiply with 6

You can multiply by 6 using a number line.


Find the product: $_$ = 6 × 4.

The factor 6 tells you to make 6 jumps. The factor 4 tells you that each jump should be 4 spaces.

So, 6×4 means 6 jumps of 4 spaces each.

Start at O.

Make 6 jumps of 4 spaces each.



Stop at 24. So, $24 = 6 \times 4$.
