## Multiply with 8

You can use Doubles to help you multiply with 8.
Find the product: $\qquad$ $=8 \times 8$.

Use Doubles.

$4 \times 8=32$
$32+32=64$
So, $8 \times 8=64$.

A) Aya has 4 boxes of turtles. Each box contains 8 legs. What is the total number of turtles that Aya's turtle have?

$8 \times 4=32$ legs


B) There are 8 shelves, with 6 books on each shelf. How many books are there?
$8 \times 6=48$ books
