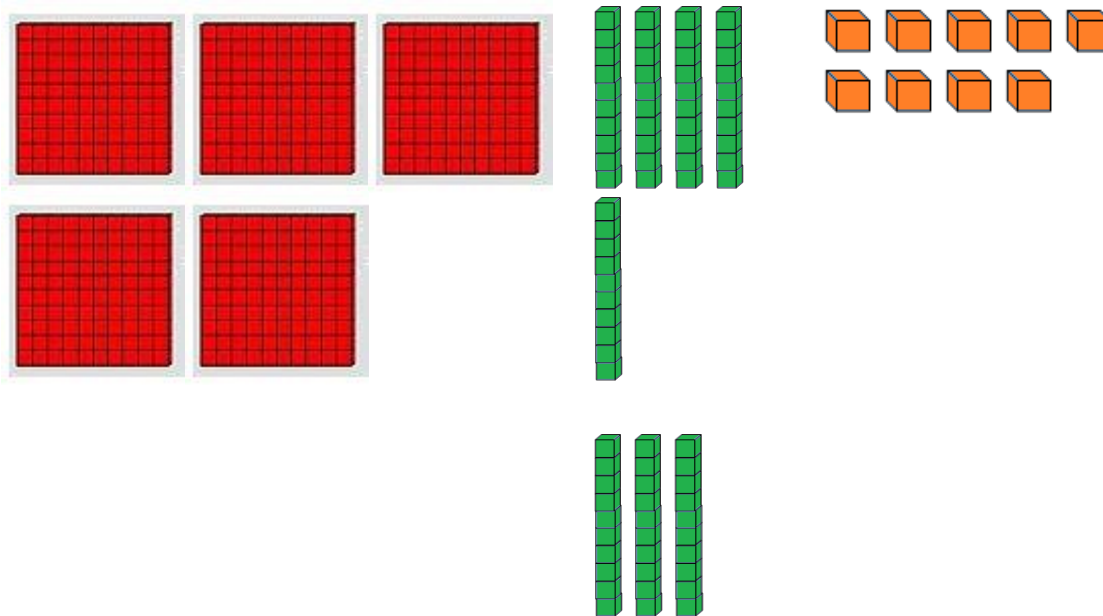


Read and Write 3-Digit Numbers

You can write a number in different ways

Look at the model



5 hundreds

8 tens

9 ones

$$500 + 80 + 9$$

589

Examples:

A) Read the number. Write the number in different ways

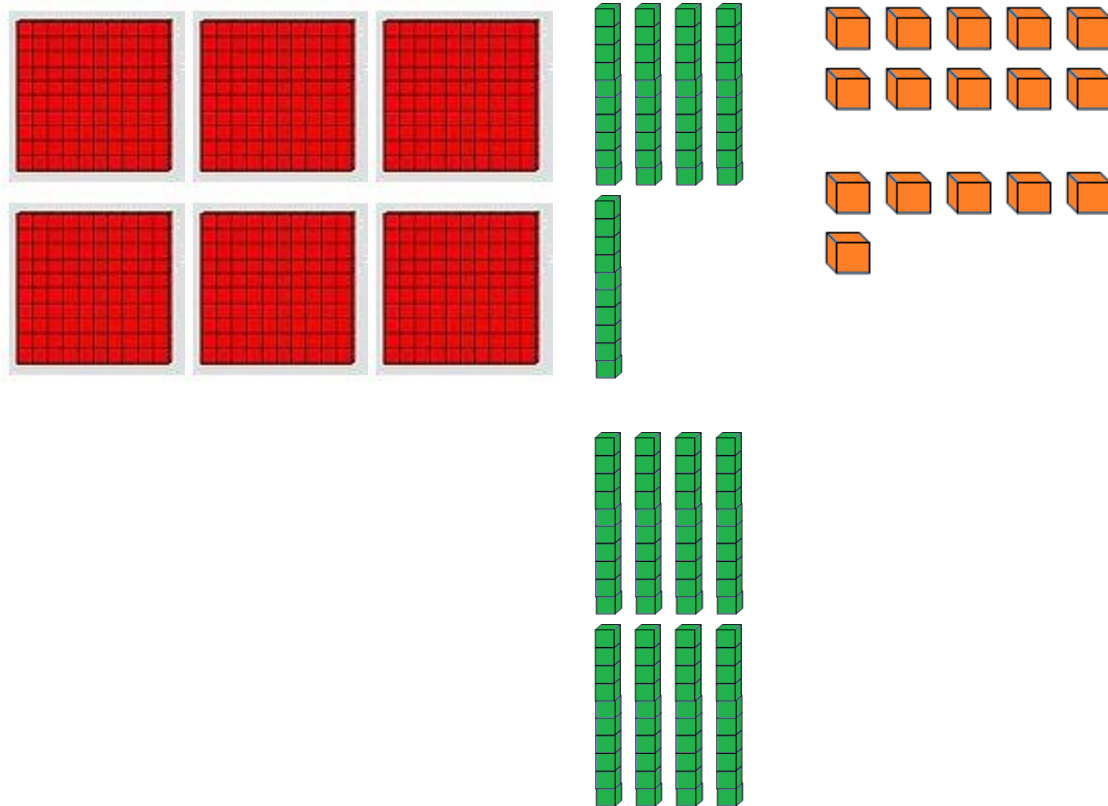
1) six hundred twenty-three

$$\begin{array}{r} \underline{6} \text{ hundreds } \underline{2} \text{ tens } \underline{3} \text{ ones} \\ \underline{600} + \underline{20} + \underline{3} \\ \underline{623} \end{array}$$

2) five hundred one

$$\begin{array}{r} \underline{5} \text{ hundreds } \underline{0} \text{ tens } \underline{1} \text{ ones} \\ \underline{500} + \underline{00} + \underline{1} \\ \underline{501} \end{array}$$

Consider the model



6 hundreds

13 tens

16 ones
