

Understand Subtraction


(-) is a *minus sign*.

This sign means *subtract* or *take away* one number from another.

When you subtract one number from another, you find *how many more* or *how many less* one number is than the other.


Subtract to take a way part of the group

Nour has 7 small car toys.



She gave her sister 3 cars.

How many cars does Nour have?




Count the cars that are not crossed out. Nour has 4 cars now.

$$7 - 3 = 4$$

My Real Life

A) There were 8 frogs by a pond. Then 5 frogs jumped away. How many frogs were left?



$$8 - 5 = \underline{3} \text{ frogs}$$

B) There were 6 frogs on a log. Then all 6 frogs jumped off. How many frogs were left?



$$6 - 6 = \underline{0} \text{ frogs}$$
