Add and Subtract Decimals

When you want to find the sum or difference of two decimal numbers, follow the steps listed below:

STEP 1: Write the number in vertical form. Remember to align the decimal points.

STEP 2: Write the decimal point for the answer. Place it directly under the other points.

STEP 3: Add as you would add whole numbers. Remember to regroup if needed.

Imad is buying school supplies.

Binder \$4.59	Paper \$1.85
Pen \$1.05	Highlighter \$0.89

The total cost of Imad's school supplies is \$8.38.

\$4.59

1.85

1.05

+ 0.89

\$8.38

Now suppose Imad pays for his supplies with a \$50.00 bill. Find the amount of change he should receive.

STEP 1: Write the number in a column. Remember to align the decimal points.

$$-8.38$$

STEP 2: Write the decimal point for the answer. Then subtract as you would with whole numbers, regrouping as necessary.

\$50.00

-8.38

\$41.62

Imad should receive \$41.62 change.

Examples:

A- Find the sum or difference.

<u>+5.84</u> <u>- 56.902</u> **74.07 88.97** 3) 48.910

-25.451

88.97 23.459

B- Place the decimal point correctly in the answer.

5) 45.98 - 7.53 = 3845

277.773

<u> 38.45</u>
